Recycled content: cotton: ≤ 20% from pre-consumer material (yarns, fabrics, fibres) or from pre-consumer material (trimmings/frayed knitwear or combing waste); polyester: ≤ 20% from post-consumer material (PET bottles) or from pre-consumer industrial yarn waste. Partly produced with flame-retardant fibres and flame-retardant products accepted by OEKO-TEX®
